



COVID-19 Guidelines for Participants in Environmental Education Programs at Lake Laurentian Conservation Area

Updated August 22, 2022

The guidelines outlined below are meant to provide a safe environment for participants and staff while staying as true to our values and quality of Environmental Education programming at Lake Laurentian Conservation Area as possible. We are committed to providing an environment that is fun, engaging and safe. Environmental Education programs will meet Ontario and Public Health Sudbury and Districts (PHSD) recommendations.

Please Note: At the present time, we will only be accepting classes from one school per day for Environmental Education programming at Lake Laurentian Conservation Area.

Prior to Arrival at Program at Lake Laurentian Conservation Area (LLCA)

- **Pre-Screen:** All persons (students, teachers, volunteers), attending or participating in an educational program at LLCA must pre-screen for symptoms of COVID-19 prior to arriving on site. Here are links to [online school screening for students](#) and [information for the general public](#). Teachers will be responsible for confirming that screening has been completed; we will confirm completion of screenings with the lead teacher on arrival.
- **COVID-19 Symptoms:** Anyone experiencing a symptom of COVID-19 will not be allowed to attend programming at LLCA.

During Environmental Education Programs at LLCA

- **Hand Hygiene:** Hand sanitizer (60-90% alcohol) will be available for use during programming.
- **Masks/Face Coverings:** Participants are required to follow the measures being followed at their school regarding masks/face coverings on the day they are attending. Conservation Area staff will wear masks indoors.
- **COVID-19 Symptoms:** Students showing COVID-19 symptoms during an education program at LLCA will need to be isolated from the group and supervised by a teacher/ or designate until they can be picked up by a parent/guardian. Once home, participants/parents should complete the screening tool and contact their healthcare provider if advised.
