Our camp instructors are fully trained, have a passion for inspiring a love of nature in children, and are dedicated to creating a fun learning environment for all campers!

Children may only be registered in a maximum of **two** sessions.

Fee: \$280 per child per week. For children aged 6 to 12 (must be turning 6 by the end of 2024).

Theme A - Survivor, Lake Laurentian: Camper favourites such as canoeing, pond study, fishing, Survival Game, and archery as well as orienteering, hikes, games, and crafts relating to wilderness survival skills.

Theme B – Branching Out – The Secret Life of Trees: Camper favourites such as canoeing, pond study, fishing, Survival Game, and archery as well as nature related games, crafts, hikes, and activities giving campers a glimpse into the secret life of trees.

Session 5 (French language programming) is offered in French only. Campers must be able to fully understand and communicate in French.
