Duties

- Present outdoor environmental education programming for K-12 students visiting Lake Laurentian Conservation Area
- Present outdoor environmental education outreach programming for classes in their schoolyards
- Plan and prepare activities for summer day camp
- Supervise campers and present activities such as canoeing, fishing, pond studies, archery, crafts, team building etc. to groups of campers
- Preparation and take-down of materials for daily programming
- Other duties as assigned by the supervisor

Eligibility Requirements

- Background in the areas of Education, Biology, Forestry, Fish and Wildlife, Environmental Programs or Outdoor Leadership preferred
- Bilingualism (French – English) strongly preferred.
- Candidates must be between the ages of 18-29
- Successful candidates will be required to provide a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sectors Screening

Additional Information

- The **Environmental Education Program Leader** will be seasonally employed by Conservation Sudbury. The primary work site will be the Lake Laurentian Conservation Area (2309 South Bay Rd).
- The maximum work period will be from May 6, 2024 to August 23, 2024, inclusive.
- The **Environmental Technician** will be paid \$16.55 per hour plus 4% vacation pay. WSIB coverage is included but no other employment benefits are provided. The normal work week will be 35 hours, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Compensation for approved overtime will be through time-in-lieu and not cash payment.
